**SPECIAL CALLED MEETING 1**

The City Council of the City of Sherwood met for a special called council meeting on February 11, 2013, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Those present were Mayor Virginia R. Hillman, City Attorney Steve Cobb, City Clerk Angela Nicholson, Aldermen Brooks, Harmon, Lilly, McMinn, Butler, Heye, Keplinger and Sanders.

City Clerk Angela Nicholson gave a count of the petition referendum on Ordinance 1953. Petitions were turned in containing 1,461 signatures, of which 1,316 were valid. The cured petitions turned in contained 292 signatures, of which 264 were valid, for a total of 1,580 valid signatures.

**Resolution No. 2-2013, entitled, "A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE FILING OF A PETITION FOR REFERENDUM SEEKING TO REFER TO THE VOTES THE QUESTION OF THE ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE 1953, DETERMINING THE SUFFICIENCY OF THE PETITIONS, CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"** was read.
