AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2362 REGARDING COUNTRY CLUB ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, SIGNING OF CONTRACTS, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Sherwood City Council passed Ordinance 2362 on April 26, 2021 regarding Country Club Road Street & Drainage Improvements Project, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance authorized the mayor to accept a low bid having a dollar amount not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) above the engineer's estimate for cost of construction of \$4,689,085.00 (Four million six hundred eighty-nine thousand eighty-five dollars), and

WHEREAS, bids for construction were opened at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 7, 2021 and read aloud and a low bid of \$7,323,413.20 (Seven million three hundred twenty-three thousand, four hundred thirteen dollars and twenty cents) was submitted by Weaver-Bailey Contractors, Inc. of Conway, Arkansas, and said amount exceeds the twenty-five percent (25%) threshold established in Ordinance 2362.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SHERWOOD, ARKANSAS:

- Sec. 1 The City Council hereby dispenses with the twenty-five percent (25%) limitation set in Ordinance 2362 and subsequently accepts the low bid of \$7,323,413.20 (Seven million three hundred twenty-three thousand, four hundred thirteen dollars and twenty cents) as submitted by Weaver-Bailey Contractors, Inc. of Conway, Arkansas.
- Sec. 2 The Mayor is authorized to award a contract for construction to Weaver-Bailey Contractors, Inc. and to sign any other documents necessary for the completion of the Country Club Road Street & Drainage Improvements Project as required, including any necessary rights-of-way, permanent easements, or temporary easements and the costs thereof.
- Sec. 3 Given the urgency to have construction underway and funds encumbered and expended prior to a deadline specified in the particulars of the first bond issue, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage.
